Groby Neighbourhood Plan Review
The Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004
Screening Determination notice under Regulation 9(1)

Regulation 9 of the above Regulations requires Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council, on behalf of Groby Parish Council (the “responsible authority”), to determine whether the Groby Neighbourhood Plan Review is likely to have significant environmental effects.

Essex County Council Place Services in consultation with Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council, following consultation with the Environment Agency, Natural England and Historic England, determined that the Groby Neighbourhood Plan is unlikely to have significant environmental effects. It is therefore considered that a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) and Habitats Regulation Assessment (HRA) are not required.

This notice fulfils the publicity requirements in accordance with Regulations 11(1) and 11(2).
